Summary:

This fulltime position requires the ability to successfully operate a residential truck on residential routes to collect and transport solid waste/recycling to disposal facilities. Assist in physically loading waste. Responsible for safely, efficiently, and courteously serving customers. Position requires good interpersonal skills necessary to interact with people both inside and outside the Company. Must be flexible and able to work morning schedules beginning at 4:30 am Monday through Friday with occasional Saturday work.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Performs daily pre- and post-trip inspections. Completes and submits the vehicle condition report (VCR) at the end of the shift
- Drives the rear- load truck along designated residential routes to collect material and, when the truck is full, take it to the disposal facility.
- As route conditions require, loads residential waste/recycling into the hopper of a truck.
- Operates mechanical packer to load and compact trash/recycling from hopper into the truck body.
- Courteously interacts with customers and/or the public along the route to answer questions or respond to requests. Notifies supervisor of issues requiring management action.
- Cleans waste from the packer blade and truck body on each disposal run. This ensures that equipment operations will continue safely and productively.
- Maintains daily route/productivity sheet, and vehicle condition report (Post-trip inspection sheet).
- Other duties may be assigned.

<u>Qualifications</u> - To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

- Have a B Class or higher Commercial Driver's License(CDL) with current medical card
- Education and/or Experience High school diploma or general education degree (GED).
- Language Skills Ability to write, read and interpret documents.
- Mathematical Skills Ability to add, subtract, divide and multiply.
- Computer Skills Ability to use a computer and perform required functions of the job.

Physical Demands: While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly required to sit, stand, climb, lift, walk and use hands to finger, handle, or feel. The employee is frequently required to talk or hear. Maneuvers in and out of tight spaces to load and unload containers. Travels busy and congested roads and highways.
